

# **Sale Festival 2012 Photographic Competition**

As part of its celebrations for Festival Week, Sale Festival 2012 is running a Photographic Competition for keen Amateur Photographers on the theme of - **“Our Great British Heritage”**

The remarkable and surprising thing about this small country of ours is its amazing variety of people, culture, countryside and history. It's true that wherever you go in Britain, you'll find castles, stately homes, statues, churches, pubs, villages, and cities, to name but a few, and all surrounded by the beautiful British countryside that frames them. And also of course, let's not forget about the people who connect to these emblems of Britishness, the activities that take place in them and the animals that live in them - and the British weather we suffer to enjoy them!

So, whether it's a picture of your favourite castle, a city skyline, a vintage car or simply a picture of you and your friends having a drink in the pub, they are pictures that depict “Our Great British Heritage”, and we would love to see them. So come on, get snapping away, and get your entries in.

Amateur Photographers who would like to enter the competition should [submit up to 4 prints](#) to Sale Waterside Arts Centre to arrive no later than **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> May**.

**The top 20 winning prints, together with a selection of the runners up will take pride of place in an Exhibition to be mounted in the Gallery Bar at Sale Waterside for the 8 weeks after the competition judging. So you can judge your own efforts against the other entrants!**

**The winner of the Senior Competition will receive a fabulous prize of £100, which will be officially presented to them during Festival Week, with runners up prizes of £50 for second place and £25 for third place.**

**In addition to the Senior Competition, there is also a Junior Section for Photographers up to 16, the winner of which will receive a prize of £50.**

## **Competition Rules**

1. The Competition Theme will be titled **“Our Great British Heritage”** and the focus should be on any aspect of British Culture and Heritage that you think best represents the competition title
2. There are no age restrictions on who can enter. The Junior Section is for entrants aged 16 or under on June 1<sup>st</sup> 2012. Family and work colleagues of the Judge and the competition organisers will be ineligible to enter.
3. **Entrants must not be professional or semi-professional photographers**
4. All entries must be in print form and can be in monochrome or colour with a maximum print size of 15” x 10” and a minimum print size of 8” x 6”  
***A maximum of 4 prints per author may be entered***
5. The Author's name, address, email address, phone numbers and age if 16 or under, and entering the Junior Competition must be clearly printed on the back of the print, together with the print title and when and where it was taken
6. The closing date for entries in the competition is 5pm on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2012
7. Prints should be posted to arrive no later than 5pm on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> May and addressed to “Sale Festival Photographic Competition”, C/O Rosie Scott, Sale Waterside Arts Centre, Sale Waterside, Sale, Cheshire, M33 7ZF  
  
Entries for the competition can also be dropped off at the Box Office at the Sale Waterside Arts Centre between 10.00am and 5.00pm, Monday to Saturday, from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> April onwards
8. There will be three Prizes for the Senior Competition:- First Prize £100    Second Prize £50    Third Prize £25  
The Winner of the Junior Competition will receive a prize of £50
9. The judges decision is final and no correspondence on that decision will be entered into
10. The organisers will not be held responsible any prints lost or damaged after their delivery (either by post or by hand) or becoming damaged either during the exhibition itself.
11. All entries must be the original work of the author and must not have been previously published. The entrants must be the sole owner of the copyright in all photos and must have the permission of any people featured in the entries
12. By entering the competition, entrants grant the right for Sale Waterside Arts Centre and Trafford Council to publish and exhibit the photographs in print, on their respective websites or in any other media as they think fit.
13. The winning prints, runners up, and a selection of other prints will be exhibited in an Exhibition of Visual Arts during Sale Festival Week and for the following 8 weeks, at Sale Waterside Arts Centre
14. ***Please note that photographs entered in the competition will not usually be returned to the Authors as many of them will be mounted on polystyrene or mount-board for display in the exhibition and consequently cannot be removed without damaging them. If you do not want your print to be displayed, but would like it returned, please indicate this on the back of the print.***
