

Sale Festival 2015 Photographic Competition

As part of its celebrations for Festival Week, Sale Festival 2015 is running a Photographic Competition for keen Amateur Photographers on the theme of

“At Work or Play”

We would love you to enter the competition, and with a theme like this, the opportunities are vast.

But "At Work or Play", what does it mean ??

Well basically, it's anything that you perceive of as being related to work of any kind, or Play of any kind., or indeed, a combination of the two.

It could be a picture of workers on a building site, people having fun on the beach, a game of cricket or football, or anything else you care to think of that depicts the theme in the way you interpret it.

The list is endless.

And we're not trying to define where Work and Play starts and finishes - we'll leave that for you to decide ! In fact, professional rugby players and footballers fit the bill on both counts !

All around you in everyday life you will see instances of "Work or Play " and the possibilities are limitless - an engine driver at the East Lancs Railway, or a Market Trader and many, many more.

Wherever you go, you'll find examples of "Work or Play" and you won't have to travel far to encounter great shots - and we would love to see them

Amateur Photographers who would like to enter the competition should submit up to 4 prints to Sale Waterside Arts Centre to arrive no later than Monday 1st June 2015.

The top 20 winning prints, together with a selection of the runners up will take pride of place in an Exhibition to be mounted in the Gallery Bar at Sale Waterside for the 4 weeks after the competition judging. So you can judge your own efforts against the other entrants

The winner of the Senior Competition will receive a fabulous prize of £100, which will be presented to them during Festival Week, with runners up prizes of £50 for 2nd place and £25 for 3rd place.

There is also a Junior Section for Photographers up to 16, with the winner receiving a prize of £50.

Competition Rules (Also see salephoto.org.uk or salefestival.org.uk websites for the Rules)

1. The Competition Theme will be titled “At Work or Play” and the focus should be on any aspect of that topic that you think best represents the competition title
2. There are no age restrictions on who can enter. The Junior Section is for entrants aged 16 or under on June 1st 2015
Family and work colleagues of the Judge and the competition organisers will be ineligible to enter.
3. **Entrants must not be professional or semi-professional photographers**
4. All entries must be in **un-mounted** print form on good quality paper, and can be in monochrome or colour with a maximum print size of 15” x 10” and a minimum print size of 8” x 6” ***A maximum of 4 prints per author may be entered***
5. The Author’s name, address, email address, phone numbers and age if 16 or under, and entering the Junior Competition must be clearly printed (lightly), on the back of the print, together with the print title and when and where it was taken
6. Prints should be posted to arrive no later than 6pm on Monday 1st June and addressed to “Sale Festival Photographic Competition”, C/O Rosie Scott, Sale Waterside Arts Centre, Sale Waterside, Sale, Cheshire, M33 7ZF
Entries for the competition can also be dropped off at the Box Office at the Sale Waterside Arts Centre between 10.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday, from Monday 9th March onwards
7. There will be three Prizes for the Senior Competition:- First Prize £100 Second Prize £50 Third Prize £25
The Winner of the Junior Competition will receive a prize of £50
8. The judges decision is final and no correspondence on that decision will be entered into
9. All entries must be the original work of the author and must not have been previously published. The entrants must be the sole owner of the copyright in all photos and must have the permission of any people featured in the entries
10. By entering the competition, entrants grant the right for Sale Waterside Arts Centre and Trafford Council to publish and exhibit the photographs in print, on their respective websites or in any other media as they think fit.
11. The winning prints, runners up, and a selection of prints from all entrants will be exhibited in an Exhibition of Visual Arts during Sale Festival Week and for 4 weeks, at Sale Waterside Arts Centre

12. Please note that photographs entered in the competition will not be returned to the Authors as most will be permanently mounted on polystyrene board for display in the exhibition.

If you don't want your print to be displayed, but would like it returned, please indicate this on the back of the print and it will be left for collection in the Waterside Box Office
